Answers to commonly asked questions

Q: I KNOW that I ordered a search, but when I went to the screen to review my order, the searches that I had selected are missing. What happened?

A: When you select a search, make sure that you click the Add button. If you do not Add the search item, it will not become a part of the search request. This is a security feature that ensures that search requests are actively created.

So don't forget to click the Add button!
